## Abstract Format and Questions

- You need to have at least 1 confirmed presenter to complete the online submission (includes speaker details, photo, and bio)
- There can be a maximum of 2 presenters for an abstract talk
- Provide a 250-word abstract, written as a paragraph of text (no bullets, graphs, tables)
- Provide 50-word snapshot summary
- Provide 2 questions for the session moderator to ask you
- Provide a website link relevant to your submission, if applicable
- Only submissions via the Abstract Submission Portal will be accepted

## Review of submissions

An external panel evaluates submissions based on research/project quality, topicality, comprehensiveness, and clarity. Successful abstracts will be scheduled, and presenters must complete registration.

## Registration of all speakers

All speakers must register and pay the discounted speaker registration fee. Fee is payable upon receiving notification that your abstract has been accepted. Speaker registration should be completed by 29 May 2026.
